

RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 132.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2004-80, WHICH ESTABLISHED A PROCESS FOR SELECTING AND ACQUIRING ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE, WATER RESOURCE PROTECTION AND RESOURCE BASED RECREATION LANDS PURSUANT TO THE VOLUSIA FOREVER PROGRAM BY AMENDING SECTION 5(5) TO ALLOW REMOVAL OF GROUP B CATEGORY PROPERTIES AFTER TWO (2) RANKING CYCLES INSTEAD OF THE CURRENT FOUR (4); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2004-80 was adopted by the County Council on April 15, 2004.

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend said Resolution to advance the responsiveness and viability of the project list to address current and future conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OPEN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED IN THE COUNTY COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT THE THOMAS C. KELLY ADMINISTRATION CENTER, 123 WEST INDIANA AVENUE, DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 21st DAY OF AUGUST, 2008, A.D., AS FOLLOWS:

Section 5. Steps of the Land Selection Process.


(5) Based on a recommendation of the Volusia Forever Advisory Committee, a property may be removed from the Group B Category by the County Council upon the expiration of at least ~~four (4)~~ two (2) ranking cycles.

Section 2. Severability. In the event that any word, phrase, clause, sentence or paragraph hereof shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other word, clause, phrase, sentence or paragraph hereof.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
